Good Hope City Council Minutes June 5, 2023

- 1. Call to order: Mayor Randy Garrett called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm, Councilmember Keith Prather led the invocation and Councilmember William Malcom led the pledge.
- 2. Roll Call: Performed by City Clerk Missy Daigle, Councilmembers William Malcom, John Robison, Jr., and Keith Prather were in attendance, Councilmembers Kelsey Malcom and David Mullis, Jr. were absent.
- 3. Approval of agenda: There were no amendments to be added, Councilmember Keith Prather made a motion to accept the agenda, Councilmember William Malcom seconded and all approved.
- 4. Approval of previous meeting's minutes: Councilmember William Malcom made a motion to accept May Council minutes and Councilmember John Robison, Jr. seconded, all approved, motion passed and minutes were recorded.
- 5. Public Forum: Tonya Wallace, with Good Hope Together, spoke about the outcome of the Poppy Festival. She stated that she had all good feed back and that vendors were already asking for next years date.
- 6. Committee Reports/Updates:
 - A. Budget Update: The council was presented with a year-to-date report. Councilmember John Robison, Jr. made a motion to accept the budget report and Councilmember Keith Prather seconded the motion. All were in favor and the budget report was approved.
 - B. City Hall rentals: Nothing new to report.
 - C. Display Case for Memorabilia: Councilmember William Malcom has checked on various types of cabinets and concluded that the cabinet would need to be custom made. After council discussion it was decided that he would check with Steve Brown at the Monroe Museum and also with Custom Wood Interiors for prices. This cabinet will be located where the desk is now and it was also decided to have a second cabinet built that would be placed under the T.V. cabinet for the old minute books.
- 7. Unfinished business: There was no unfinished business.
- 8. New Business:
 - A. Alternate date for July Council Meeting: Due to the Fourth of July holiday Councilmember Keith Prather made a motion to change the July meeting from the first Monday of the month to the second Monday, July 10, 2023, Councilmember John Robison, Jr. seconded the motion, all were in favor and the motion passed 100%.
 - B. - 9. Council Discussion Items for the good of the order: Mayor Garrett discussed with the council the need to commit the cities ARPA funds, after discussion it was decided that Councilmember Keith Prather would look into prices for new benches and tables for the pavilion area.
- 10. Adjourn: Councilmember Keith Prather made a motion to adjourn the meeting, Councilmember William Malcom seconded, all approved and the meeting was adjourned at 7:22 pm.
