Good Hope City Council Minutes

November 10, 2025

- 1. Call to order/Invocation/Pledge of Allegiance:** Meeting was called to order at 6:30 by Mayor Garrett; Mayor Garrett led the invocation, and Councilman Young led the pledge of allegiance.
- 2. Roll call:** Performed by City Clerk Crissy Robison; Councilman Robison was absent.
- 3. Approval of agenda:** Mayor Garrett called for a motion to approve the November agenda. Councilman Young made a motion to approve the agenda, seconded by Councilman Malcom all approved, motion passed, and agenda was approved.
